

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

East 5th Street – Segment 2 Paving

Paving activities for Segment 2 of East 5th Street are scheduled for **September 13, 2022**. Segment 2 contains a significant amount of paving and will require that the contractor begin early in the day to place pavement with paving operations continuing late into the day. Traffic, noise, and lights will cause additional inconvenience on this day and into the early morning hours of September 14th. **Families and students should exercise additional caution when commuting during peak traffic hours during this busy construction activity.**

Paving will be continuous throughout the day to avoid unnecessary cold joints in the new street. Several hours after the pavement is placed, the contractor will sawcut joints in the pavement to prevent damage. The window to complete this work is small and will require work to be done late that evening and into the early morning hours the following day. This will be an isolated occurrence and we ask for your patience as this is completed.

Traffic Impacts

- Concrete trucks will begin arriving on site around 6:00 AM on 9/13/2022
- Trucks will access the construction area using David Drive until the paver reaches that point.
- Trucks will access the construction area using Windsor Drive for the section of road between David Drive and Windsor Drive.
- Trucks will access the construction area using Kingston Drive for the section of road between Windsor Drive and Kingston Drive.

Noise Impacts

- Concrete trucks and paving crews will increase noise levels adjacent to E. 5th Street with work estimated to take place between 6:00 AM and 4:00 PM on 9/13/2022.
- Sawcutting will begin in the afternoon and will continue until finished. This is a loud activity and will be disruptive. **Sawcutting work is estimated to take place between 3:00 PM and 4:00 AM the night Segment 2 is paved.**
- Generators will be required to power flood lights necessary for sawcutting operations.

Segment 2 is expected to open to local traffic on September 26, 2022. Segment 3 work will begin that day. Notice will be provided 1 week prior to closing Segment 3 and making any traffic control adjustments.
